### **Description:**

In the morning we took a bus which took us to the port of Cartagena, where we visited the Naval museum. Here the students could see a real submarine and learn about life on board of a navy submarine, as well as about an evolution of submarines in the Spanish navy. The Peral submarine from 19th century that we saw, was designed and constructed by Isaac Peral here in Cartagena.

The pupils were also interested in the scale models of sailboats and ships that they had the opportunity to see here.

After a lunch we had together, we took a walk around the city center, where we also had a guided tour of the Town Hall built in 1907. It was beautiful. During the walk along the port and the city center the students from both countries had the opportunity to get to know each other better.







**Results**: The project aim was to present to students the main points of the local history and important places. Students were interested in the museum exposition as we do not have sea, which made the excursion very educative.

### **Description:**

We had the opportunity to visit another exceptional place in Cartagena, the Concepción castle. We took a lift to a hill and on the top of the hill we had a guided tour of the Concepción castle. From there we had a great view of the whole town, including the Roman Amphiteater as well as the Cartagena's port. From there we walked towards the Roman theater, which in ancient times used to host around 6000 people. It was stunning.

During the guided tours delivered in English, the students could practise their language skills. They could undersand how wide and important the Roman Empire was at the ancient times and how influential it was throughout the whole Europe.

**Results**: Students enjoyed the guided tour, they had the chance to ask questions about history, see monuments in real, and live what they learned in history lessons. This was only possible thanks to the mobility week. Students could interact with each other, and Spanish kids were very proud to show parts of their history to the Slovaks.

### **Description:**

We attended a very interesting lecture by the Spanish popularizer of natural sciences, Cayetano Gutiérrez, who explains physics, chemistry and biology in a very engaging way on his you tube channel.

He carried out several experiments with balloons, rope, flame, aluminum foil, eggs, water and plastic bottles. He also talked about healthy eating habits. His lecture was a great success among the students. They could try out some of his experiments, which was a great added value to his lecture. They could see some physical or chemical laws in practice and understand them better. By this activity students learned more in a practical and interactive way, as they could try things and they had to think about them critically and use logic too.

**Results**: Using STEM method in teaching is very good way to show students how things work, and students enjoyed the activity a lot. They learned in a funny way.

### **Description:**

Before lunch, we walked to a near by playground, where we were introduced to the local game called "Bollos Cartageneros", which the students had the opportunity to try. This game is similar to pétanque but it is played with wooden balls. The goal is to hit three wooden sticks with the wooden ball. The students found it difficult but each of them had a go. This game is part of the local cultural heritage. In the Region of Murcia, located in the southeast of Spain, there are currently two types of bowling: Bolos Huertanos (bowling from vegetable patch) and Bolos Cartageneros (bowling from Cartagena). The Cartagena bowling game is a form of bowling in the city of Cartagena and its region (Campo de Cartagena), which has been known since the 16th century as a pastime of manual workers in the area, farmers and miners. The playing field is a rectangle called a lane and is made of compacted earth, of large dimensions in a terrain without unevenness or obstacles or irregularities, with a width of 8 to 11 meters and a length of 72 to 90 meters.

**Results**: It was a nice time spent together and see what sport is traditioal in the region of Cartagena.






























# Farewell party, certificates


