The legends about Cathedral of st. Elizabeth

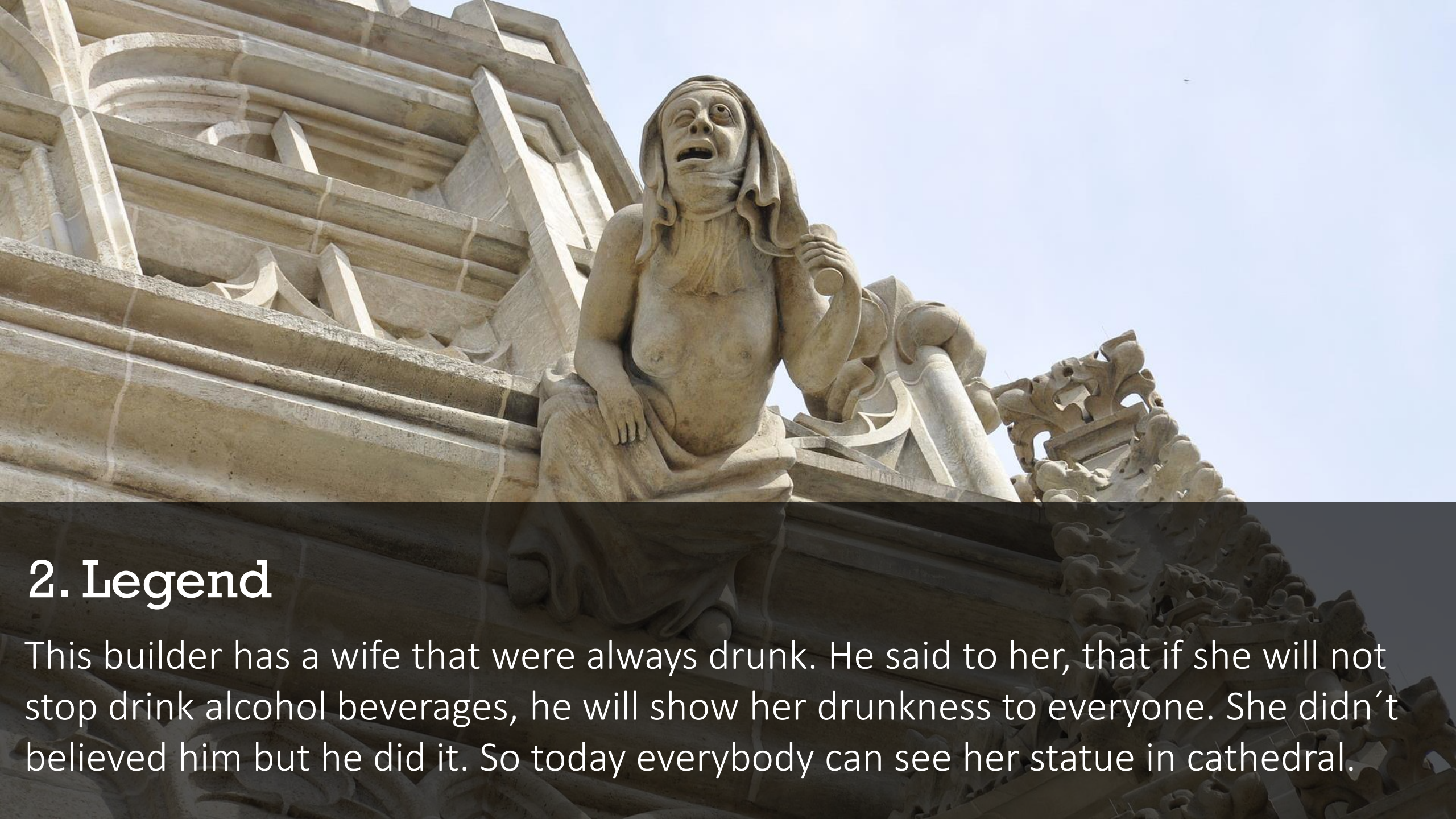
1. Legend
